



## R.T. Ramsey

July 3, 1922 - December 27, 2009

R.T. Ramsey Jr. of Pauls Valley, OK entered this life on July 3, 1922 born to Rufus Turner and Nannie Bell (Witt) Ramsey in Davis, OK and departed this life December 27, 2009 at the age of 87 years.

Mr. Ramsey grew up in Davis and attended schools there. He later attended college at Southeastern in Durant, OK. When the war began in Europe and Japan he enlisted in the U.S. Army Air Corps and piloted B-17s . After the war he met Mary Jolly at the Rock Café near Turner Falls. The couple was married on December 23, 1949 in Fletcher, OK and made their home in Davis until moving to Pauls Valley in 1953. Mr. Ramsey operated the Mobil Service Stations until his retirement in 1983.

R. T. was a member of the First Christian Church of Pauls Valley where he served as church treasurer for many years. He enjoyed playing with his grandchildren, being with his family and was an avid reader.
