Ruby Lee (Robbins) Harbison entered this life August 4, 1926 born to Lee and Trudie Buel (Britton) Robbins in Milburn, Oklahoma and entered eternal life surrounded by her loving family on January 23, 2010 at the age of 83 years. Ruby grew up in the Tishomingo and Milburn area of Oklahoma and attended Filmore School. Ruby bore much of the responsibility of raising her brothers and sisters while her parents worked long hours to provide for the family. The home Ruby grew up in was a Christian home and her family worshipped at the local Church of Christ together. Ruby married Cecil Harbison on August 11, 1945 in Tishomingo, Oklahoma. It was important to Ruby that her family remain close and take care of each other.
