Ryan Glen Bastholm Peacock of Pauls Valley, Oklahoma was born to Richard and Kathleen (Payne) Peacock on January 9, 1984 in Glenwood Springs, Colorado and passed from this life on April 30, 2014 near Byars, Oklahoma at the age of 30 years.

Ryan grew up and attended school in Dewey, Oklahoma until the sixth grade. He graduated from Elkins High School in Missouri City, Texas. On February 3, 2006, Ryan married Erica Reneé Simmons in SugarLand, Texas and made their home in Houston, Texas. Ryan was a Staff Sergeant in the U. S. Marine Corps Reserves and a Department of Corrections officer. He served in Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan while Erica and their children moved to Pauls Valley, Oklahoma. Upon his return home from the military, he served as Director of the Toy and Action Figure Museum. Ryan assisted in starting the International Super Hero Day. In his spare time he enjoyed fishing, camping, re-enactments, and playing the drums. The highlights of his life were obtaining the rank of Eagle Scout, serving a mission for the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints in Sacramento, California in American Sign Language, and most importantly his children. 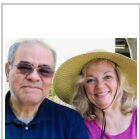
