Sarah Marguerite Moody of Elmore City, Oklahoma was born to Albert Lee and Ethel (Edwards) Brewer on April 28, 1920 in Elmore City, Oklahoma and passed from this life on March 15, 2010 in Lindsay, Oklahoma at the age of 89 years, 10 months and 15 days.
