Stanley J. Williams of Elmore City, Oklahoma was born to J. T. and Imogene (Runyon) Williams on May 25, 1946 in Wynnewood, Oklahoma and passed from this life on January 2, 2017 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma at the age of 70 years.

Stan grew up and attended school in Elmore City, Oklahoma. He graduated from Dibble High School. He served his country in the U. S. Navy in May of 1964 and was stationed on the U. S. Kitty Hawk during the Vietnam War. During his service he was a Parachute Rigger 3rd Class and was assigned to squadron RVAH 13 out of Sanford, Florida. On October 23, 1970, Stan married Linda Gail Taylor in Ada, Oklahoma. Together they made their home in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma until 1977 when they moved to Elmore City, Oklahoma. Stan worked for Lindsay Well Service for seventeen years. He also worked in maintenance at the Southern Oklahoma Resource Center for twenty years. Stan also did tile setting on the side.

He broke horses bareback, riding them until sweat boiled off their backs, becoming his. Stan taught his children to love all animals and treat them with respect. Fair and honest, his word was his word and paid cash for everything he bought. He had a schedule for everything. Stan and Linda raised three children and two others. He was the love of Linda's life and a perfect father.

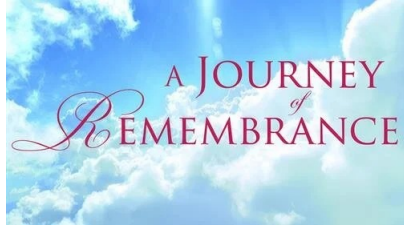
