Stephen Paul Blanscet was born on October 07, 1935 in Sayre, Oklahoma to James Andrew and Nellie (Stroud) Blanscet and passed from this life on Sunday, December 25, 2011 in Pauls Valley at the age of 76 years. Paul grew up in Sayre and attended Reydon High School. Later he went to Amarillo, Texas where he was employed by Furr Food Distributing Warehouse. He then moved to the west coast where he began working with the U. S. Navy. On February 19, 1962, Paul married Marilyn June Roach in Oxnard, California. After Paul retired from the Navy in 1990, he and Marilyn moved to the Elmore City community in the fall of 1996. Paul was a member of the First Baptist Church of Elmore City where he taught an adult men's Sunday school class. Paul enjoyed coin collecting.
