Terry Allen Stanley of Foster, Oklahoma was born to Orville and Geraldine (Hunt) Stanley on June 1, 1954 in Flora, Illinois and passed from this life on December 30, 2014 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma at the age of 60 years.

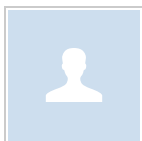

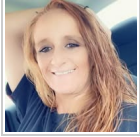
