Thomas E. Forehand of Lindsay, Oklahoma was born to Hugh and Lillie (Smith) Forehand on November 5, 1916 in Lindsay, Oklahoma and passed from this life on June 26, 2007 in Norman, Oklahoma at the age of 90 years. Thomas grew up and attended school in Lindsay, Oklahoma. He was among twenty-one citizens to vote on making Lindsay a town. He served his country during World War II in the U. S. Army from 1942 until he was medically discharged in 1946. Thomas worked as a telephone repairman and had been a lifelong resident of Lindsay and member of the First Baptist Church there.
