Tommy Lee Day, a lifelong resident of Pauls Valley, Oklahoma, passed away peacefully on April 20, 2025, at the age of 67. 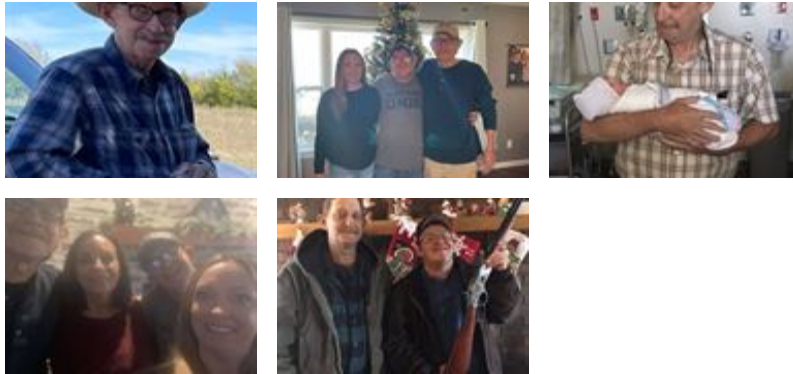
