



## Vera Waunice "Dimple" Cassell

August 27, 1920 - February 24, 2009

Vera Waunice "Dimple" Cassell of Elmore City, Oklahoma was born to Luke and Winnie Park Graves on August 27, 1920 near Elmore City, Oklahoma and passed from this life on February 24, 2009 in Purcell, Oklahoma at the age of 88 years.

Dimple grew up near Eola, Oklahoma. She rode a one eyed brown horse to school at Prairie Point and walked to Satterwhite later to attend school. When she was ten years old, Dimple moved to Foster, Oklahoma to live with her aunt, Bertha Graves Risenhoover. She later moved to Ada, Oklahoma to work for a physician, caring for his children. In 1936, Dimple married Veneta David Cassell. Together they made their home in Wynnewood, Oklahoma where three of their children were born. Veneta and Vera moved to California for some time before returning to Oklahoma. They made their home in Elmore City where they had lived ever since. Dimple worked as a waitress for Clark Caves at Kent's Truck Stop. She enjoyed caring for the sick and was known for her famous yeast rolls and her mischievous sense of humor.
