Vernon Edward "Skeeze" Tillery of Elmore City, Oklahoma was born to John Marcus and Lizzie Arvella (Chennault) Tillery on June 28, 1933, in Antioch, Oklahoma and passed from this life on April 5, 2023, in Sulphur, Oklahoma at the age of 89 years.

Skeeze grew up and attended school at Davis school, Maysville, and Elmore City. During high school, he was the recipient of the Lions Club swine program. He was saved and baptized at Satterwhite Missionary Baptist Church in August of 1954 and ordained as a Deacon on his birthday on June 28, 1963.
