Victor Valiant Cross of Foster, Oklahoma was born to Oscar Iris and Thelma Prudence (Whitley) Cross on January 24, 1937, in Foster, Oklahoma and passed from this life on November 28, 2022, in Duncan, Oklahoma at the age of 85 years.

Victor grew up at Foster, Oklahoma and attended school at Doyle. He served in the Army National Guard of Oklahoma Battery A Battalion 158th from 1958 to 1964. He worked various jobs over the years: school bus driver; stocking and delivery clerk; farmer/ranch hand night watchman lawn mower and air conditioner repair; and had his own cattle business.
