Warren Bradley, Jr. of Pauls Valley, Oklahoma was born to Warren B., Sr. and Missie (Love) Bradley on September 19, 1925 in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma and passed from this life on March 3, 2009 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma at the Veteran's Hospital at the age of 83 years.

Warren lived in Pauls Valley until the age of twelve, when his family moved to California. Warren returned to Pauls Valley to make his home in 1994. On April 19, 1966, Warren married his wife, Janet in Las Vegas, Nevada. He worked as a food chemist for Westco Products in Los Angeles, California. After retiring from Westco Products he pursued his own fried pie business in Bell Gardens, California, later moving his business to Tishomingo, Oklahoma. The business was called Nikki Pies, named after his son who was killed at age 19 in a motorcycle accident. Warren retired in 1997 and in his spare time he loved to hunt and fish. He was very proud of his grandson Nunu and his granddaughter Taryn. He loved sports and attending his grandson's basketball and football games. Playing board games with his wife and grandson was one of his favorite pastimes. Warren had a great knowledge of the Bible and a love for music. He belonged to the Jehovah's Witnesses but was unable to be active in recent years due to failing health. The highlights of his life were his wife, his children and grandchildren.
