Warren F. Mills of Pauls Valley, Oklahoma was born to Ed and Mary (Davis) Mills on August 24, 1919 in Wakita, Oklahoma and passed from this life on November 17, 2010 in Pauls Valley, Oklahoma.

Warren grew up in Wakita, Oklahoma on a wheat farm where he loved to hunt and fish. He married Rozelle Carpenter on October 2, 1942 in Sherman, Texas. He served in World War II in the U.S. Army Air Corp in Independence, Kansas. Warren and Rozelle moved to Pauls Valley, Oklahoma in 1946 where they owned and operated the Plaza Motel for 36 years.
