William (Bill) Walter Barckholtz, 68, of Pauls Valley, OK, died January 30, 2012 at Pauls Valley General Hospital.

The second of three boys, Bill was born on November 20, 1943, in Saginaw, MI., the son of Dorothy and Norman Barckholtz.

Bill enlisted in the US Navy in 1961 and served three years. He then enlisted in the US Air Force, serving with distinction until his retirement in 1982.
